Outside judges were chosen and all went well. Jazz students enjoy the dessert showcase. Spoke about the need for advertising for Little Mermaid. A.Zall is leaving DGN to go to graduate school at the University of Michigan. The open position will become a separate position for DGN and DGS. We will be hiring a Head Orchestra full time position that is a string specialist. The position is posted.

- b. Fundraising
  - i. Dessert Showcase J. Van Houtan Recapped the event and thanked all volunteers. Over 140 performers, visual art students displayed art, 209 tickets sold, increase of ticket sales from last year, faculty and staff were thanked. Had 19 student volunteers, 33 parent volunteers. Hundreds of desserts, 23 silent auction items yielded just under \$4000. 12 raffle items

were obtained. 50/50 split the pot was \$470. 26 supporters, 4 sponsorships. Speakeasy raffle raised \$375. Grand total raised \$12,374 after expenses; this was an increase from last year.
